OUR SERVICES

We offer a range of services to cater to most lifestyles and needs. All clients have access to our Helpline & can contact us at any time with Questions.

All clients must complete a DISCOVERY SESSION first. This is 60-90 minute session completed remotely. This session is intended as an Education & Assessment Session where we will discuss:

- The Behaviours & Why they might be happening
- How a Herding Brain Works
 - How our Dogs Learn
 - What is Force Free Training?

We then work with the Owners to create a Training Plan based on their goals , lifestyle and available time to commit to training. We aim to set our Teams up for success by providing them the education needed to understand and work with their dog right from the start.

IN PERSON PRIVATE SESSIONS

In Person Private Training sessions are offered within a 15 minute radius of Pakenham, Cranbourne and Drouin areas. We also offer Travel-Fee-Free days regularly to Frankston. These sessions are offered on Saturday afternoons after 2pm and on Sundays from 10am. These sessions are best for handlers who are new to training and require assistance & confidence building in their own handling skills.

JUMP START SESSIONS

These sessions are offered on a Wednesday within a 15 minute radius of Pakenham, Cranbourne & Drouin. Clients need to sign up for a half-term (5 weeks) or a full term (10 weeks) at a time. These are weekly sessions without the owner present and are best for those who are time-restricted or who do not feel safe & confident handling their dogs. They can also be good for maintaining consistency with training.

REMOTE SERVICES

We offer remote services worldwide via the Google Meet Platform. We also provide our clients the option to check in remotely when they just need to ask questions or clarify something but don't need a full session.
